Staff Reports-Alice Wright/ Kids Korner

- I. Both centers are closed for the month of May following the Governor Pritzker's orders.
- II. Staff disinfected all toys, walls and frequently touched surfaces in all the classrooms/ bathrooms.
- III. Both centers are working on improvements to the buildings and continuing to clean each week. We would like to ensure you that the cleaning will be heightened extensively upon return and will continue as recommended by the local health department and the CDC. Staff will be provided with up to date training on the most current and best practices for a safe and clean environment.
- IV. Staff began to hold meetings through Zoom in order to connect with their students. They will continue to be holding weekly or bi-weekly meetings.
